The silvered dial has Arabic numerals and minute markers on the chapter ring and is inset with hour and seconds subsidiary dials. The Herter Bros oak case having a bonnet with gabled straight pediment with opposing carved masks in profile over a fret-incised frieze, and full carved lion heads flanking the paneled sides. Fluted columns with carved mask pilasters center the dial. Burl veneers and ebonized spandrels and molding throughout. A shaped glazed aperture centers the single panel front door of the case opening to the mercury pendulum within. The clock terminates on its concave foot, and rests on its conforming lozenge-form two-door credenza base. The credenza is fitted with a single full-width drawer, and has at its sides, ornately carved columns centered between lion paw pilasters with bacchanalian capitals.

The body with a wide neck and compressed ovoid body raised on a pedestal base, the neck and main section cast with scattered blossoms picked out in multicolored enamels and reserved on a finely patterned thunder-pattern ground; the hemispherical shade with an en suite openwork design of linked colored enamel blossoms terminating in a tall finial and lined with cream-colored silk (electrified, soiled, some wear). (Approx. 24 3/8" tall overall).

- A pair of patinated bronze jardinières. Meiji/Taisho era. Each cast with a waisted neck and ovoid body applied with a pair of elephantine handles etched with cloud scrolls, the sides decorated with two sinuous dragons in raised relief, the short pedestal foot supported on a circular dark-stained wood base (loss of patina, corrosion). (Approx. 8 3/4" tall, 12 3/4" wide).
- Cast bronze stick neck vase Comprised of a tall waisted neck supporting opposing dragon form handles atop a globular body adorned in raised dragon and smoke motifs all supported by a flat foot. (Approx. 11" tall).

A Kangxi dish, covered in large bird and flower reserves to the interior, the exterior adorned with simple floral sprigs, the recessed base centered by a makers' mark (chips); A late Ming kraak dish of typical design consisting of an elaborate flower lappet band encircling insect and flowers centering the well (repaired). (Approx. 10 3/4" & 11 3/8" dia).
- A mixed wood portable desk, Late Qing dynasty with earlier elements. The elaborately pieced folding support stand, originally part of a dressing case, centered with a qilin panel and hinged to the low rectangular case fronted with a single drawer, the back of the drawer having a storage area with its own sliding door cover (assembled, wear and separating age cracks). (Approx. 5 1/4" x 18" x 15 1/2").

A square form brush pot incised to the sides in archaistic calligraphy and stylized landscapes, the underside bearing an impressed makers mark perhaps reading Su Shenglan Zhi; (2) tea canisters of hexagonal section adorned in floral motifs to the sides; a hexagonal wine jar formed of a separately potted

interior canister nested within a hexagonal heating jar adorned in an baxian motifs, the base impressed with a five petal prunus blossom maker's mark; and a clear glazed miniature stick neck vase bearing an impressed makers mark reading Zisha Yini (damaged). (Tallest: approx. 9").

- Chinese Blue and White Basin and a Vase. 18th Century censer or basin of bombé form surrounded by dragons vying for pearls amid tufts of smoke, the underside centered by a double ring (rim restored) (8 3/4" diameter); the second a late Qing cylindrical vessel encircled by lion dogs amid clouds and smoke, the underside bearing a four-character Kangxi mark (notable chips) (12 1/4" tall).
- Two Porcelain figures of Guanyin, 20th C. One modeled seated on a hollowed rock rising from waves, the hair twisted in a high chignon and the chest embellished with thick strands of jewelry, the right hand resting on the raised right knee, the figure seated beside a Dehua censer and accompanied by the young acolyte Shancai holding out his hands in prayer; the other modeled in a similar pose, now cradling a ruyi scepter in her left hand and with a long sash billowing down towards lotus leaves rising from waves. (Approx. 12" & 12 3/4" tall).
- Yixing Lion Figure & (2) Chopstick Holders. Lion figure potted in dark-hued clay, the feline seated on his hind legs and tail curled to one side holding his head aloft, the eyes highlighted in black slip and hollow mouth open in a humorously confused expression; with two small lion-form chopstick holders of possible Japanese/Okinawan inspiration or manufacture. (Largest: 4" long).
- Mottled green jade carved figure. The long and narrow rock carved as a water bird landing on a faceted rock next to a plaited fishing basket while a crab at the other end crawls onto the water grasses fronting the basket, a gray layer in the matrix used for the crab carved from amber patches forming the heads of the water grass and a portion of the mouth on the basket (minor chips). (Approx. 11 1/2" long).
- Korean mixed soft woods chest on stand, 20th C. The low rectangular case constructed with a thin wood veneer top, eight functioning drawers fronted with various veneers and yellow brass handles on one long side and a pair of false doors that do not open on the reverse side, the attached low stand supported on four curved feet joined with transverse base bars on the short sides (wear, cracks to veneer). (Approx. 23 1/8" x 36 3/8" x 17 1/8").
- Qing dynasty mixed woods altar table. Constructed with two boards of uneven width forming the top set into a mitered, mortise-and-tenoned frame above a beaded edge and straight apron joined to cut-out spandrels flanking tubular legs joined to paired side rails (refinished, separating age cracks). - Pair of Chinese Blue and White porcelain fish bowl planters. Each of octagonal section, the bombé walls painted with a shou-character centering the composite lotus flowers blooming amid leafy tendrils, the unglazed foot and recessed base covered with an iron wash. (Approx. 18 1/2" tall).

Beads on the shorter necklace of milky white hue with tiny patches of light leaf green, with yellow metal clasp; those on the longer necklace of medium green hue with tiny flecks of dark leaf green, with white metal clasp.
